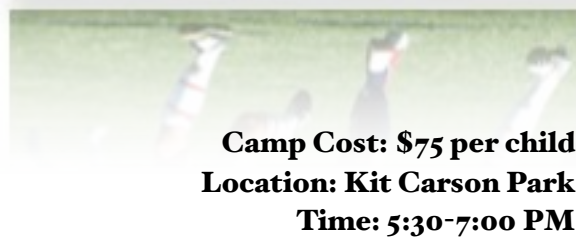

Sixteenth Annual Skilz Camp

In 2006 Michael was selected to host a skills training seminar at the Rio Vista FC Annual Coaching Symposium. The Skills Session was filmed by *Rio Vista FC* (New Mexico's largest competitive youth soccer club-Albuquerque) for staff training.

In addition to regular club duties around the state for the past four seasons Michael has been the technical skills trainer for the Taos High School Tigers helping to lead them for the first time in school history to four straight New Mexico High School State Championship playoff appearances and their first ever Division AAAA District 2 title in school history.

Michael was also the coach/skills trainer of the (2003) 3V3 U.S. National Champion Runner-up *Taos Hurricane U-14 boys* team & the three time defending National Champion (2002-U-13 , 2003-U-14 , 2004-U-15) *Las Tormentas girls'* team. Both the Taos Hurricane & Las Tormentas qualified for the U.S. National Championships seven straight years (Taos Hurricane, 1998-2004) & (Las Tormentas, 1999-2005).

Mr. Hensley has also been the Technical Skills Trainer for the following teams:







In 1995 Michael founded and coached the first all girl's soccer team (*Taos Eagles*) in the region, Mr. Hensley coached the U-12 and U-14 Taos Eagles from the fall of 1995 through the spring of 1998. In total, fourteen of those girls were named to the Class AAAA New Mexico High School All State soccer team. In addition, Michael is currently training a number of youth athletes that have been selected to participate on age appropriate teams within the Region IV Olympic Development Program and the Young Olympian Program.
